REMINDERS

Could we ask you to phone us if your child is unable to attend nursery. It is part of our safeguarding policy and it is helpful to have attendance numbers.

If your details change, such as phone number, address please let us know ASAP.

Please bring a piece of fruit into nursery, each day, which will be shared at snack time.

For your information, Nursery staff will sign the register each day when you drop your child off, and at the end of the day when you collect your child. This is **MOST IMPORTANT** so that we have an accurate record of attendance at all times.

If you are going to be late for your agreed pick up time, please text or phone the nursery phone.

This is a matter of courtesy towards our staff

Children who are unwell should be kept at home. It is only fair to your child and to the other children and adults in the setting. If a child becomes unwell during the day or appears to have any infectious symptoms, the parent/carer will be contacted and they are expected to come and collect their child immediately

We are flexible with regard to arriving at Sunrise, anytime before 9 am is fine. From 9, more formal learning begins downstairs and it is best if

the classroom is not disrupted. In the baby room, there are more activities between 8am and 9.15, then we have snack time.

Please take your and your child's shoes off before taking your child upstairs.

Clothing

May we ask you to provide a pair of indoor slippers, 2 sets of spare clothes, spare nappies, wet wipes

As it is (hopefully) going to get warmer, please make sure your child has two changes of appropriate clothes, a rainproof jacket and if you wish, sun cream or a summer hat as we go out every day, rain or shine

We hope you all have set up your tapestry account. We want to encourage you to login often to check your child's progress at Sunrise. Please get in touch with your child's key person if you need help with this.

Security

Please do not allow anyone to come in with you or after you. Ask them to buzz again and a staff member can open the door for them.

Homeopathic Clinic

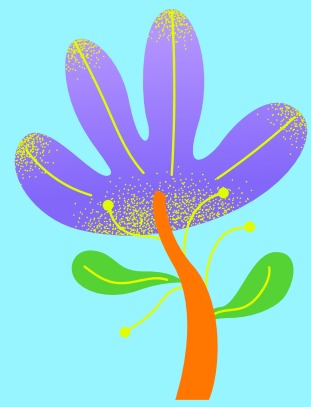
We hold a homeopathic clinic at our

and adults 3 Saturdays every month.

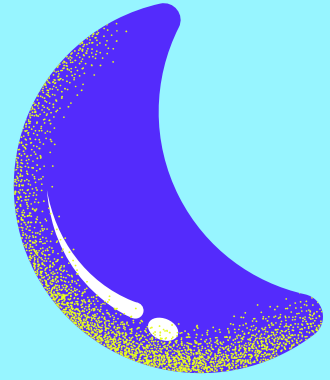
